INTERNATIONAL JURY REPORT

Wiki Loves Earth is a photo contest of the natural monuments, where participants picture protected areas and upload their photos to Wikimedia Commons. The goal of the project is, on one hand, to picture under a free license as many natural monuments and protected areas as possible, on the other hand, to contribute to nature protection by raising public awareness.

After years of successful organisation of Wiki Loves Monuments there was an idea of a similar contest for natural monuments. The idea of Wiki Loves Earth was born in April 2012 during a discussion at Wikimedia Conference. The idea was realised for the first time in Ukraine, where the contest was held from 15 April to 15 May 2013. Wiki Loves Earth became international in 2014 with 16 participating countries from four continents, and expanded its geography further in the following years.

In 2021, during the ninth edition of Wiki Loves Earth 34 countries and territories all over the world organized local contests. Among those, 2 teams have joined the competition for the first time: Wales, United Arab Emirates. The contest lasted between May 1 — August 31. Usually, WLE takes place between May and June, but due to the world health situation and positive experience of extending the contest in 2020, it was extended by two more months. We have received more than 64 000 submissions from over 4300 uploaders.

The contest has two categories this year - landscapes and macro/close-up photography.

ABOUT WIKI LOVES EARTH

HOW THE JURY WORKS

Winners were determined by the 6-person international jury. Members were selected by the international team. The jury team was formed to be as diverse as possible: they are representatives of six countries and different continents. International jury members are experienced Wikimedians and professional photographers.

390 nominations were submitted to the international organising team by the national juries of the participating countries. Each country was allowed to submit up to 15 images, not more than 10 from each category.

The nominations were collected in a judging tool managed by non-voting jury moderators. After pre-filtering ineligible files all photos were submitted to the jury.

On the first stage, all jurors rated all images with stars from 1 (poor) to 10 (very good). 48 images with ratings higher than 6 were selected as candidates for the final round.

On the final stage, jury members rated (from 1 to 20) and commented on the 48 images. Comments were visible to other jury members, while rankings were not. These rankings were added together, and a combined jury ranking was produced. In case of equality of points in the final round, points from the first round were used as a tiebreaker. Photos were also checked for relevancy and if they depict a protected area.

INTRODUCE THE JURY

ANJA STRELEC, BELGIUM

Anja is an audiovisual and documentary film director and photographer based in Belgium. She is currently working on different audiovisual projects for BBC Studioworks, Belgian TV and European Commission as well as audiovisual trainer for different agencies and EU delegations. For the last twelve years she has been working as an independent TV journalist, documentary filmmaker, photographer, camera operator, editor and coach. Anja directed and co-directed several awarded creative documentaries and promotional films. Moreover, she had an opportunity to work for different clients in an international environment such as in Nepal, Argentina, Ghana, Eritrea, Guinea and all around Europe. Most of her work is concentrated on social, environmental and development topics as well as audio-visual portrait storytelling, institutional and music videos.

OSAMA SILWADI, PALESTINE

Osama Silwadi is a Palestinian photojournalist, visual storyteller, archivist and folklorist. He worked with several local press organizations, French Press Agency, Reuters. In 2004, he founded the Apollo Agency, the first Palestinian photography agency. In 2009, he founded and edited the “Wamid” magazine. Osama was a jury member of several photography awards and contests, such as “Youth Eyes on the Silk Road” organized by UNESCO, Wiki Loves Monuments conducted by the Wikimedians of the Levant user group in 2017 and 2018. Silwadi’s photos were published in leading international newspapers and magazines, such as National Geographic, Time and Newsweek. He also has held many local and international exhibitions, including in Palestine, Jordan, Egypt, United Arab Emirates, Italy, United States and France. Osama was the international jury member of the previous WLE edition in 2020 and was glad to continue contributing to the contest this year.

SUMMER KAMALELDEEN, EGYPT

Summer is a professional photographer from Egypt practicing for already 5 years including wildlife photography. He has organized the local competition Wiki Loves Africa for two consecutive years, as well as won the international round of Wiki Loves Africa for two years in a row. In addition, he received an award in the International Competition for the Elderly in Bahrain and became a winner of the Wiki Loves Monuments competition last year.

CARLOS FIGUEROA, CHILE

Carlos Figueroa is a Chilean dentist and active Wikipedian since 2005 and has contributed to Wikimedia Commons since then. As a part of Wikimedia Chile board since 2017, chair since 2020, he has been in charge of the “Chile in images” project which portrays the main cultural events in the country. Also, Carlos was a member of the national jury of 2018 and 2019 editions of Wiki Loves Earth, and jury for other photographic contests, such as “6 months that changed Chile” and “Revealing Sites”. Carlos was the international jury member of the previous WLE edition in 2020 and was glad to continue contributing to the contest this year.

ARJUN SURI, INDIA

Arjun is a filmmaker and photographer based in Mumbai, India. Over a decade he is working on projects across a wide range of audio-visual crafts including screenwriting, directing, editing, cinematography and photography. One of his directions in photography is travel and landscape, which is especially valuable for Wiki Loves Earth photos evaluation.

MOHAMMED MUSTAPHA ALIYU, NIGERIA

Mohammed from Nigeria is an active Wikimedia contributor and community organizer that has joined the movement since 2017. He also co-founded Hausa Wikimedians User Group. Since then he has been carrying out projects to promote Wikimedia projects in Hausa language for the reach of its speakers. Mohammed is an urban planner working on environmental design and ecology. He is interested in beauty and cultural adaptation of the natural environment. In addition he practices photography.

Mount Merapi is located on the border of Central Java and the Special Region of Yogyakarta, has an altitude of 2,930 meters above sea level. Since the end of 2020 until now Mount Merapi is erupting. The eruption of Mount Merapi is estimated to only be in the form of molten / incandescent lava without an eruption. The frequency of incandescent lava discharge can reach dozens of times a day. The farthest sliding distance from incandescent lava reaches 2,200 meters.
